HOUSING

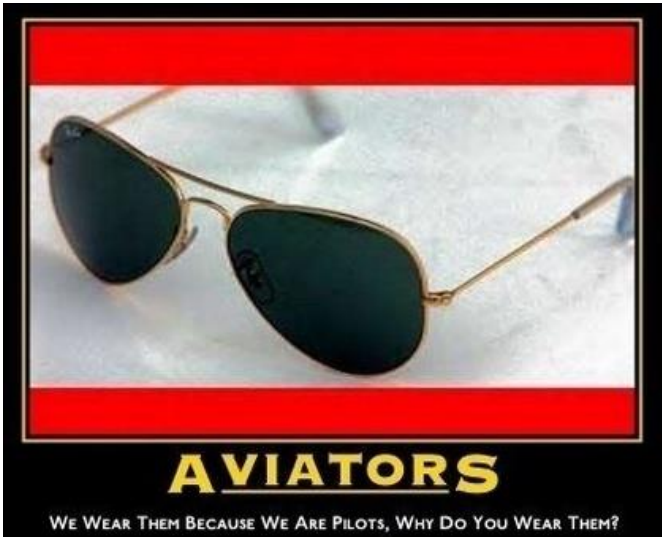
Superior can provide housing for \$200 per week. Ask for additional details.
